Thierry Bouhours is a Visiting Research Fellow at the Australian National University Regulatory Institutions Network. He studied psychology and criminology at Griffith University, Brisbane. His doctoral thesis examined the relationship between psychosocial traumas in childhood and criminality in the life course focusing on the role of education and pedagogies. In 2007 his research interests shifted to the comparative analysis of criminal victimization in S.E. Asia, and particularly the historical and contemporary patterns of violence, crime, and policing in Cambodia.
